

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Your 2017-2018 Alcoholic Beverage license expires at midnight on December 31, 2018.

Please take note that failure to have your license renewed by this date will require you to re-apply for a <u>new license</u> and appear before the Alcohol Beverage Licensing Board before you can serve or sell alcohol in your establishment. The earliest available meeting will be held the first Thursday in January 2019.

THIS MEANS IF YOU DO NOT RENEW BY DECEMBER 31, 2018, YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO SELL ALCOHOL <u>AT ALL</u> UNTIL THE NEW LICENSE IS ISSUED.

Any renewal application not filed on or before the last City business day prior to October 31, 2018 may be assessed a late filing penalty of \$250.00.

Payment in full is required with the submission of the renewal application.

POURING LICENSE RENEWAL FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2019

October 1, 2018

All holders of licenses to sell liquor, beer or wine by the drink in the City of Roswell are notified that your license will not be renewed unless you have complied with Section 3-7-3 of the *City of Roswell Alcoholic Beverages Ordinance*. This provision requires that the serving of meals shall be the principal business conducted, with the serving of alcohol consumed on the premises as only incidental thereto. More than 50% of the outlet's income must be derived from sale of food on the premises. All requests for renewal must show that the business has complied with this provision.

Each applicant for renewal of a pouring license will show the amount of income derived from the sale of food and the amount of income derived from the sale of alcoholic beverages and the gross amount of income received for the twelve (12) months indicated, or for the months that the license was granted. These figures are subject to audit by the City of Roswell.

NOTICE & AFFIDAVIT TIPS (Training Intervention Procedures)

Chapter 3, Article 3.2, Section 3.2.10 of the Alcoholic Beverage Ordinance of the City of Roswell requires certification of the licensee of a restaurant, convenience store, grocery store and package store by attendance at TIPS (Training Intervention Procedures Program) or approved alternative program that shall be verified and signed off by the Chief of Police.

The applicant shall have 6 months from the date of the granting of the license to complete such training and submit certification to the Alcohol Beverage Licensing Board.

Licensees who have had TIPS training and have received a Certificate of Training from the Roswell Police Department need not repeat the class.
