

Bridge Replacement on Old Holcomb Bridge Road

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PROJECT OVERVIEW

This project is anticipated to replace the weight-restricted bridge over Big Creek on Old Holcomb Bridge Road. This bridge was constructed in 1941 and is currently deemed structurally deficient and functionally obsolete. The bridge is still safe for automobile traffic and has been inspected by GDOT engineers; however, the bridge is currently weight-restricted, prohibiting larger trucks. Any major construction activities necessary to support construction of the nearby Big Creek Parkway project may require that this bridge be replaced.

Total Project Cost: \$3.1 million
