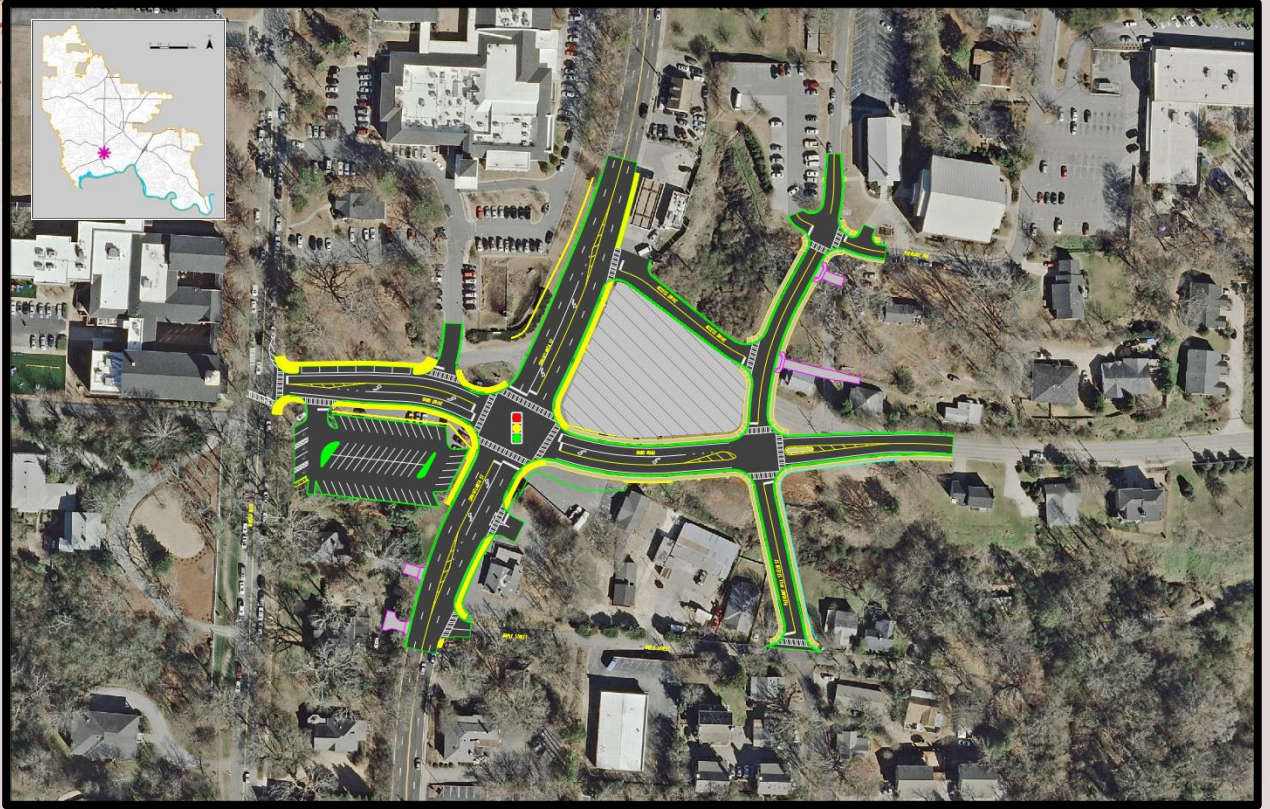


Atlanta St. /Oxbo Road Intersection

PROJECT OVERVIEW

This project consists of the realignment of Oxbo Road and Oxbo Drive to eliminate the staggered intersection at SR 9/SR 120/Atlanta Street and to convert Oxbo Drive to a two-way street between Mimosa Boulevard and Atlanta Street (SR 9/120).

The project also provides new turning lanes on both Hwy 9/Atlanta Street and Oxbo Road and adds a new traffic signal at the intersection. This project will also include extending Elm Street from its existing terminus at Maple Street to the intersection of Oxbo Road and Pleasant Hill Street. The project will also extend Oxbo Road west to connect to Mimosa Blvd for better access to SR 120/Marietta Hwy and the Magnolia Street/Pine Grove Road corridors.

Construction is expected to begin in Spring 2019.
